

Team Architects Scholarships 2018

Information sheet

Team Architects New Zealand is a consortium of nine practices through-out New Zealand from Auckland to Wanaka who practice both independently and also collectively as Team Architects Ltd. With a strong design emphasis Team Architects have specialist ESD skills and a hands-on approach to project management. As a significant employer of architecture graduates, with over 80 staff, we are keen to strengthen the links between the Schools of Architecture and practice.

This being the 13th year of the Team Architects Scholarships they are the only national award competed for by 1st year Masters of Architecture (Professional) students. It is awarded to assist with the completion of M Arch (Prof) studies in the following year.

The Awards

The Scholarships are offered to 1st year Masters of Architecture students studying at, and who have completed a Bachelor of Architectural Studies (BAS) at one of:

- Victoria University of Wellington,
- University of Auckland,
- UNITEC Institute of Technology.

Team Architects Scholarship Supreme Award

The monetary value of the Team Architects Scholarship Supreme Award is **\$3000** and is presented with a certificate.

Team Architects Scholarship Distinction Awards

Two Scholarship Distinction Awards of **\$1000** may be awarded to students from each of the other two Schools of Architecture with a certificate.

Successful candidates are to use the Scholarships for study in the following calendar year for completion of their degree on providing evidence of enrolment.

Application & Submission

To apply you must be in the 1st year of a Masters of Architecture (Professional) programme in a New Zealand School of Architecture.

You are required to submit the following:

1. the main final project in the design course from the first semester of 1st year of Masters (It is not necessary to especially prepare a portfolio);
2. a brief explanation of the programme brief/s and your approach – no more than half an A4 page;
3. application form;
4. official academic record for your time at University.

The work submitted shall be physical copies of not more than A3 size collated into a tidy format suitable for hand delivery elsewhere in NZ. It is not practical for the assessment to include work presented in electronic format – only printed work should be submitted.

If the final design project work is a joint project then it shall be submitted as a joint submission by the two or more participants, along with full documentation of items 4&5 for each participant.

The application form and work are to be submitted by **Friday 1st September 2017** to the Head of School c/- the School Office.

Selection Process

The award criteria will be based on an assessment of the work reflecting that student's ability to successfully complete their final year with excellence and progress into the practice of architecture.

Each School of Architecture shall shortlist **three** nominees from their applicants and forward submissions to the nearest Team Architects practice by mid-September. Each School will nominate their judges, who shall apply the above criteria.

The work from the nine nominees is then considered by the nine Team Architects offices to establish a shortlist of recipients. Individuals on the shortlist may be given an interview with a panel of two or three Team Architects directors in their city of study.

In the situation that a joint project is submitted and that body of work is selected, the scholarship will be shared.

The Awards will be announced and presented at the respective School of Architecture's end of year exhibition and award ceremonies.
